EOTAS through LEARN WITH SAT



Education Other Than At School (EOTAS) is a term for when a child with Special Educational Needs (SEND) requires a specific educational setting away from the school environment, tailored to their needs, based on provision written into an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).

“EOTAS makes educational provision for children with social, emotional behavioural, medical or other issues who, without its provision, cannot access suitable education.”

The key goal of EOTAS is to create a bespoke package of education that meets the needs of the child's EHCP. This usually includes details such as all teachers having Qualified Teacher Status (QTS), dedicated, paid time being granted to support the natural characteristics of SEND provision, and granting educational equipment where necessary such as laptops, workbooks, and desk equipment.

EOTAS should not be confused with home-education, as EOTAS places a completely different kind of responsibility from the local authority onto the parents and teachers supporting the child. Section 42 of the Children and Families Act (2014) ensures that the local authority is under a legal obligation to ensure that the child receives the education highlighted in their EHCP.



What does Face-to-Face tuition look like at LWS?



Many of the young persons we support at Learn with SAT are educated within the community, at locations such as a public library or community hall, or the family home.

Types of Education Staff Available

We have a number of EOTAS staff available from Learn with SAT.

These roles include:

- SEND Tutor
- Education Assistant
- EOTAS Coordinator



SEND Tutor

Depending on the needs of the young person, a SEND Tutor may specialise in PDA, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia etc. They will be a qualified teacher who holds QTS and for Secondary Education they will hold a subject specialism.

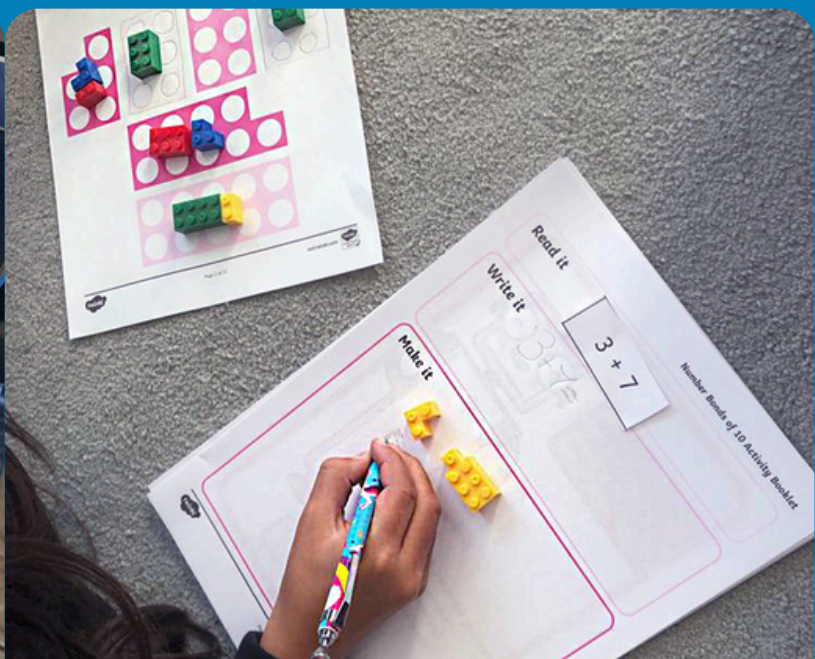
The function of the QTS is to write a weekly educational provision plan for the young person which can be delivered directly by the SEND Tutor, or completed with support from the young person's key workers and family members.

Direct Provision:

Where the young person is able to receive Tutor-led activities, the SEND Tutor will deliver educationally themed projects and activities in the young person's learning environment, which may be tailored around special interests and current events.

Indirect Provision:

Where a young person is unable to engage with Tutor-led activities, the QTS may create a bank of lesson plans and associated resources that will be shared and delivered by either the staff or family, with QTS oversight.



Learning Support Assistant

Learning Support Assistants may sometimes be known by other names, such as Education Assistant and Teaching Assistant, but they're essentially all the same role. There is no fixed job description for what an Education Assistant can offer, but generally we would expect some of the following tasks to be part of the role.



Education:

- Preparing and supporting the young person to access Tutor-led sessions, either face-to-face or online
- Accessing the community safely and learning life skills in Preparation for Adulthood (PfA)
- Support the young person with pre-learning tasks such as key words or pre-learning
- Modifying and adapting lesson materials, such as for VI or dyslexia

Therapies:

- Delivering therapy strategies overseen by professionals (OT and SaLT) such as Zones of Regulation or Sensory Circuits
- Supporting the young person to access alternative provisions such as Forest School



EOTAS Coordinator

Package set-up:

- Creation of a proposal and costings based on the provision listed in the EHCP; includes identification of training providers and services, equipment recommendations from health care professionals and resources
- Writing referrals to services where required
- Meetings with family
- Setting up of provisions such as subscription based services, online provisions such as

Staff Compliance:

- Complete compliance checks on behalf of family for all staff that they directly employ. As per the KCSIE guidance, checks include but are not limited to: references, right to work, DBS checks, qualification checks and ID checks
- Registering family with HMRC as an employer and setting up staff pensions and payroll
- Creation of a Single Central Record
- Identifying and facilitating training for staff where such training is required for compliance with young persons EHCP

Staff management:

- Chair staff supervision on a one-to-one basis with key workers/education assistants/HLTAs etc
- Chair weekly team meetings
- Chair multi-disciplinary meetings, take minutes and distribute to the MDT
- Coordinate and feedback to the QTS
- Oversee disciplinary action, where required
- Reviewing and writing employment contracts on behalf of family for all staff that they directly employ
- Timesheets and expenses
- Record keeping, including daily logs



EOTAS Coordinator

Safeguarding:

- To act as the Designated Safeguarding officer for the EOTAS package
- To provide policies, procedures and documentation for staff working with the young person
- Writing of risk assessments, where required

Annual Review:

- Collate reports from the MDT
- Complete the annual review paperwork
- Chair the annual review meeting

Education:

- Quality assure 3rd party services
- Facilitate educational visits, including risk assessments and staffing levels
- Liaise with the Educational

The EOTAS Coordinator Role is offered by myself, Sammie, and is usually quantified in Section F as a provision.



How do we source Education Staff?



Pre-screening: A dedicated member of LWS staff short-lists candidates and conducts screener phone calls

Stage 1 Interview: The Case Manager virtually interviews the candidate to confirm suitability to the role

Stage 2 Interview: The family, EOTAS Coordinator and Case Manager meet virtually with the candidate

Stage 3 Interview: The candidate attends a supervised visit with the young person

Stage 4: Compliance and on-boarding

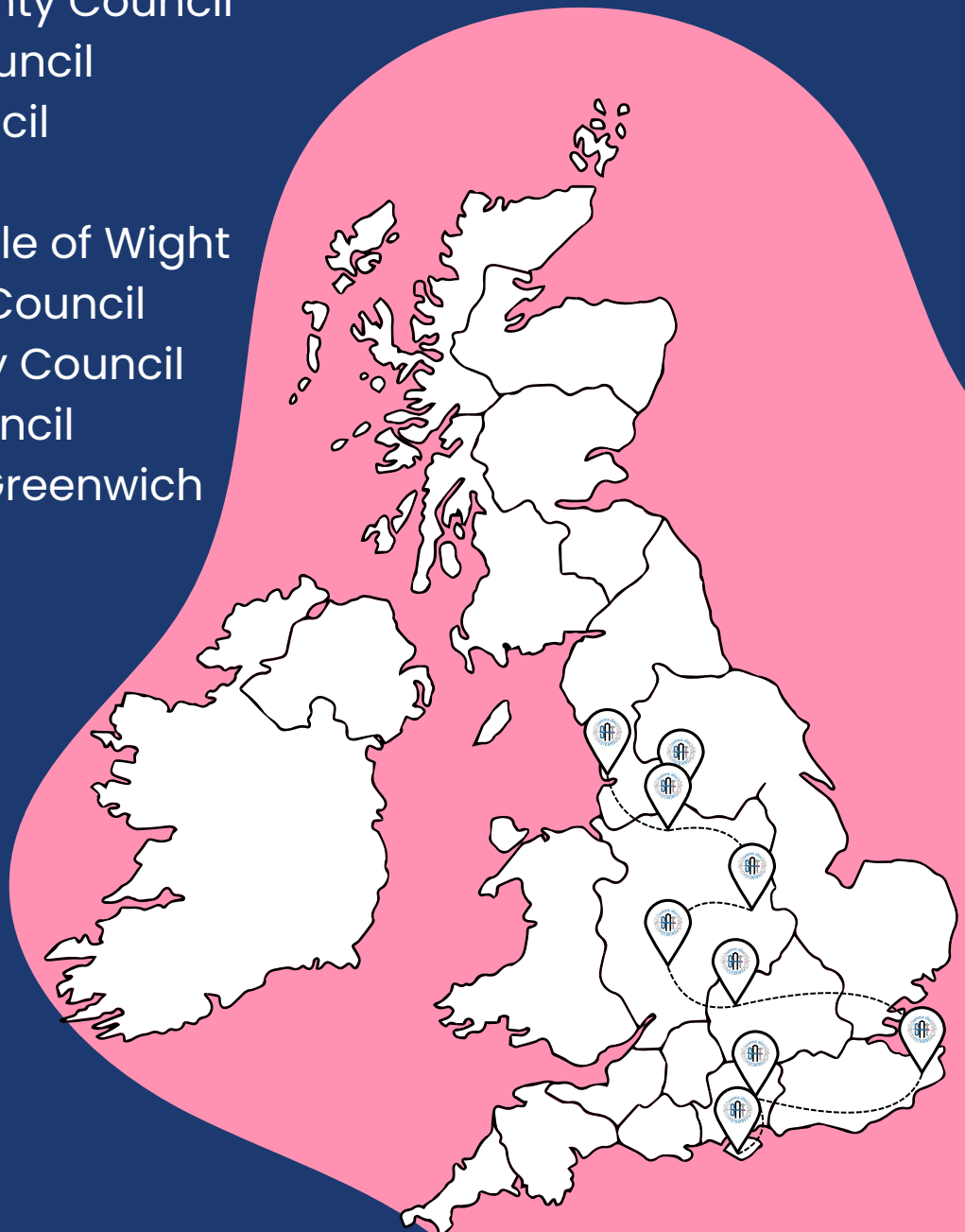


Approved Supplier List
